Design works for Additional Environmental and Sanitation works involving the relocation from Old Fadama to Adjin Kotoku

Period: May to July 2008

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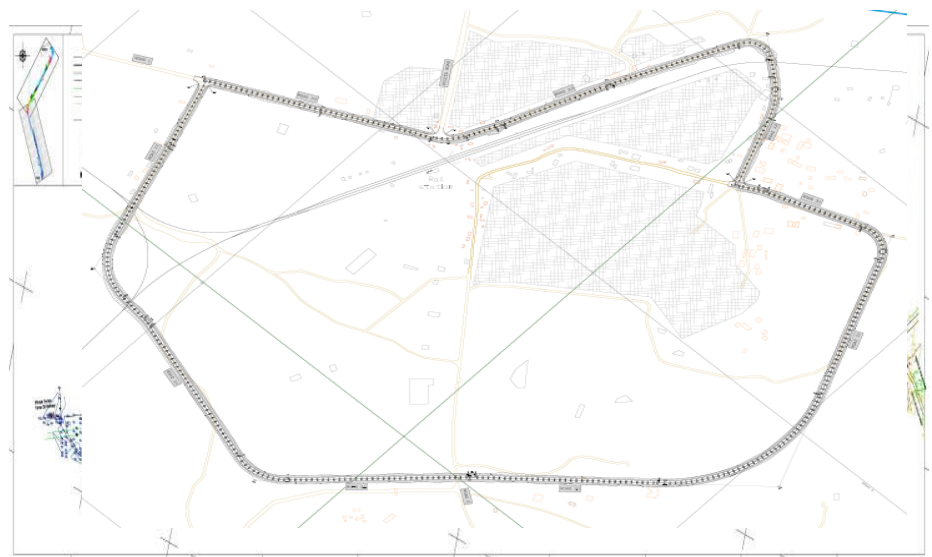
The Ministry of Ghana has identified an area located approximately 25 km outside Accra in the direction of Nsawam on the Kumasi road. The area consists of approximately 340ha. The development and creation of a new town at Adjin Kotoku will provide bulk breaking facilities for commodities coming into Accra from the North of Ghana. The area will be developed and then used for the relocation of the commercial and informal residential facilities of the settlers at Old Fadama, situated at the Korle Lagoon in Accra.

Project Management International (PMI) qualified to carry out the design and the supervision of this Project.

The Works

The works kicked off with a survey and a soil investigation, so that the design could be carried out.

PMI had to provide all necessary documentation, specifications and working drawings for construction to enable the Contractor to execute the works for this Project.



For Klerp Stage 4, PMI had to do the design of the following works:

- To design and supervise the bulk earthworks to provide a suitable developable area for the resettlement of Old Fadama, bulk breaking areas and market areas
- To determine the 1:50 year storm water flood line and design the required storm water structures
- To design and supervise of bulk services including roads, water, sewer, stormwater drainage and electrical reticulation
- Design and supervise the required bulk services for social infrastructure including health and security services, education facilities, market and transport terminal and the redevelopment of Old Fadama.
